- encourage customers to use FSC certified paper in their books and avoid using wood products from the following sources:
 - illegally harvested wood
 - genetically modified wood
 - wood originating in forests with serious social conflicts
 - wood originating from uncertified High Value Forests
- set environmental objectives and targets based on continual improvement, monitor results and review on a regular basis
- establish and maintain an Environmental Management System which continually reduces waste, effluent, emissions and the use of scarce resources.
